Applications are open all year round and you can leave whenever you want for a minimum of one month.

In which fields can I participate as a trainee or volunteer?

> Medicine and medical sciences in general

We need physicians, nurses, radiology, imaging, and radiotherapy technicians, medical researchers, physiotherapists, and the like who will serve at our partner hospital facilities.

> Education

We are looking for undergraduates and graduates in education who will serve in kindergartens in our associated facilities, where they will teach preschool age children. Advanced knowledge of the English language is not a mandatory requirement as the activities will be mostly of a playful-educational nature.

> Foreign languages and literatures

We are looking for foreign language students who want to test themselves by teaching Italian, or a foreign language (French, German and Spanish) to children from preschool age up to the age of 13. At least level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for languages is required.

> Computer engineering

To teach the basics of computer science (computer programming, artificial intelligence, approach to cybersecurity) to children between the ages of 6 and 13, we need computer engineering graduates and undergraduates.
